This memo documents an oral reprimand for a preventable accident in which you were involved that occurred on February 14, 2018 (CN#18-032-098; I/A#18-0410) while driving a department vehicle.

The details of the accident are as follows: As you pulled into the Flowerama parking lot for an off-duty traffic control shift, you moved to the right to allow another vehicle to exit. Once it passed by, you moved to the left and struck a four-inch eye bolt sticking out of the concrete, causing minor damage to front passenger side bumper on your unmarked take-home squad.

This incident was reviewed by the Department's Accident Review Board (ARB) on March 15, 2018, and it was determined that the accident was preventable due to inattentive driving.

It is the department's expectation that you drive with due care whenever you operate a motor vehicle. Additional accidents and/or failure to drive with due caution will result in further disciplinary action up to and including discharge.

You have the right to appeal this action. If you wish to do so, you should contact your union representative, who will advise you of your rights. Please take note of the varying timelines under Civil Service rules and your labor agreement.
