It's as easy as 1, 2, 3 ...

1 Accessible

Make Employment Insurance ...

We should get Employment Insurance if we lose our job:

- Access after 360 hours or 12 weeks of employment
- End harsh disqualification rules
- Ensure migrant workers get access

2 Adequate

Make Employment Insurance ...

Employment Insurance should be enough to live on and last long enough for us to find another job:

- 75% of previous income
- No less than \$600 a week
- Up to 50 weeks if we need it

3 Fair

Make Employment Insurance ...

No matter where we live or work, the same EI rules should apply for amount, duration and access to EI benefits.

Migrants work and contribute to EI but are too often unfairly denied EI income support when they need it.

Decent work and income for all

We all need:

- A \$20 minimum wage, adequate hours & paid sick days
- Stop wage theft & end misclassification
- Equal pay & benefits
- Better laws to protect workers

- When we can't work, we need at least \$600 a week, via EI or other programs & supports

2 Affordable housing

Social housing makes life more affordable

Everyone benefits from:

- Rent control for all tenants
- Investment in high quality public housing
- Keeping public land in public hands
- Keeping investment companies* out of the housing market

3 Strong public services

Public services make life more affordable

Strong public services save us money and create good, local jobs.

But only when there's enough public funding. Let's invest in:

- Health care, child care, public postal services, public transit, education, public housing, and more
- Employment Insurance by restoring federal government funding

4 Tax fairness for everyone

Tax corporations and billionaires

Corporations benefit from public services & infrastructure.

According to Oxfam, Canadian billionaires increased their wealth by \$304 million every single day in 2024.

- Corporations should not contribute less tax revenue than individuals
- Profitable corporations should pay their fair share!
