Ann Hesse

Ann chairs the Democrats Abroad Global Women's Caucus. A former chair of DA Germany Stuttgart Chapter, she has also served as Coordinator for all of DA's Global Caucuses. The former opera singer currently teaches at the University of Stuttgart.

Connie Borde & Sheila Malovany Chevallier

Connie and Sheila are the Founders of the Democrats Abroad France Women's Caucus in 1992, translators of The Second Sex in English for Random House in 2011, serve on the jury for the Simone de Beauvoir Prize and are active feminists both in the United States and France.

Salli Swartz

Salli has been living and working as a Paris based international attorney for over 40 years and is former Global Women's Caucus Chair and Co-Chair, serves on the GWC Steering Committee and chairs the Reproductive Rights Action Team.

Patricia White

Pat serves on the GWC Steering Committee and co-leads the Women's Economic Empowerment Initiative. She is a member of the DA Black Caucus, the DAF Diversity Caucus Steering Committee as well as several other women's organizations.

Julie Kay

Julie holds a J.D. and was the lead attorney who designed and litigated the landmark case ABC v. Ireland, Kay successfully argued before the Grand Chamber of the European Court of Human Rights that Ireland's ban on life-saving abortion violated her client's human rights. She is an expert on women's human rights domestically and internationally and is co-author of Controlling Women: What We Must Do Now to Save Reproductive Freedom.

Carrie Baker

Carrie holds a J.D. and Ph.D.and is the Sylvia Dlugasch Bauman Chair of American Studies and a professor in the Program for the Study of Women and Gender at Smith College. She is a contributing editor for Ms. magazine, writing regularly on women's legal rights and feminist activism.

Kati Hornung

Kati was the Campaign Coordinator for the state-wide, nonpartisan, grassroots VAratifyERA campaign to ensure Virginia became the 38th state to ratify the Equal Rights Amendment. She is the executive director of the nation-wide VoteEquality organization.

Shari Temple

Shari serves on the Global Women's Caucus Steering Committee. She is also the DA Chair of the ERA Global Task Force, the Chair of the DA T team, and Voting Representative of DA Germany.

Angela Fobbs

Angela is the founder and former Chair of the DA Global Black Caucus and current DA Germany Wiesbaden Chapter Chair. She serves in many other capacities including work on the Global Women's Caucus steering committee, the DA Environment and Climate Crisis Council and the Global IT team.

Stayce Camparo

Stayce serves as the Communications Co-Director of the GWC and is Editor of GWC monthly Newsletter. A former professional ballet dancer, Stayce is now pursuing her Master's in Sociology and Social Research at the University of Cologne.
