Prop. 2 Bypasses City Council for some housing projects and leaves approval to mayor-appointed City Planning Commission and Board of Standards & Appeals
Prop. 3 Bypasses City Council review for small projects, which includes up to 30% increase in density
Prop. 4 Creates three-member appeals board that can reverse city council decisions and eliminate city council's ability to override mayoral veto with two-thirds majority

What Props 2, 3, and 4 will do:

- ✗ Transfer power from your elected city council member to NYC mayor as well as developers and lobbyists
- ✗ Eliminate ability to fight for more affordable housing
- ✗ Allow city to ignore local needs such as schools, parks and transportation

**VOTE NO
ON 5 & 6**

Prop. 5 Consolidates and digitizes NYC's official map
Prop. 6 Moves NYC elections to Presidential years, extends current terms. However, high profile state and federal elections will likely overshadow local ones. Creates confusion in primaries because city elections have ranked choice voting and other elections do not


