Key issues that affect Downtown Manhattan residents: affordable housing, racial equity and AAPI hate, gun violence, reproductive rights, and protection from climate change.

Affordable Housing—Being able to have access to affordable housing is a basic human right. We have a housing shortage problem. People are paying too much of their earnings in rent or mortgage payments. To address this issue, I will partner with state and local officials to tackle this issue, bring in federal resources to support state and local initiatives on affordable plans, consult with community stakeholders so we could offer more affordable options to congressional district 10's residents.
