**False.** They're not intentionally marketed to appeal to those who want to avoid background checks. This may be a "Brady Projection." Maybe it's nobody's damn business and I just want to make my own gun. When the first 10 amendments to the Constitution were ratified, there were no serial numbers, background checks, magazine capacity restrictions, or gun-free zones.

People didn't register their guns with the government? As a matter of fact; the less the government knew, the better. The idea of gun ownership was that it was none of the government's business. That narrative has been carefully shaped and crafted to represent the exact opposite. It is now the opinion of some that all gun ownership should be regulated and overseen by a federal agency and that all guns should be registered with the government.
