

# Pamlico Poker Rules

- Buy in for 1<sup>st</sup> each hand is \$10, each additional hand is \$10
- Firearms will be Handguns shooting from 15 yards.
- No bench resting or prone, all shooting will be standing off-hand.
- No magnified optics.
- Any Pistol caliber (No rifle caliber pistols)
- Each hand is comprised of 2 cards dealt at the firing line.
- You will have 6 shots to complete your best Poker hand of 5, however you **must use** your 2 dealt cards.
- You will have 5 minutes to fire your 6 shots.
- Maximum of 6 shooters on the line at a time.
- You must use different cards on the target (no using the same card twice if you hit it twice).
- If you break the outline of a card that counts as a hit. This will be at the discretion of the RSO.
- You will have a sample target to study at the firing line.
- If you buy in additional hands, you will use your best hand.
- The RSO will have the final word on any issues.

Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place (not the same person)

Check-In starts at 0800 and the competition starts at 0900 with last shooters to the line @ 1200

## **RANGE Safety and Rules**

The **Range Safety Officer** has absolute authority on the range. Compliance with their instructions is mandatory.

1. ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
2. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
3. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
4. WEAR EAR AND EYE PROTECTION.
5. DO NOT MIX ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WITH SHOOTING ACTIVITIES.

Know and obey all range commands. **Cease Fire, Make Weapon Safe, Make Ready, Commence Firing, Range is Cold, Range is Hot.**

ANYONE can call a **Cease Fire** if they see and unsafe condition. When a **Cease Fire** is called, immediately Unload, open the action, remove the magazine and ground and/or bench all firearms. This is making the weapon safe. When the RSO is satisfied they will call **Range is Cold**, during this period **No One** is allowed to touch a weapon.

You may only handle your weapon when the **Range is Hot** and you are on the **Firing Line**, you will not load your weapon until you are on the firing line and you have been instructed to **Make Ready**. No one not actively on the **Firing Line** will handle a weapon even if the **Range is Hot**.

Always keep the muzzle pointed at the backstop. Never allow the muzzle to point in any direction whereby an inadvertent discharge would allow the escape of a projectile into an outer area.
