



SAFEGUARDING OUR REPUBLIC: GRIFFIN'S 2024 ELECTION STAND

WHEREAS, Judge Jefferson Griffin, a dedicated Republican and member of the North Carolina Court of Appeals, has demonstrated a commitment to the principles of justice and fairness in our electoral processes;

WHEREAS, in the 2024 election for the North Carolina Supreme Court, Judge Griffin's race was extremely close, with only 734 votes separating him from his opponent, Justice Allison Riggs;

WHEREAS, Judge Griffin has filed a legal challenge to exclude over 65,000 ballots from the total count in the 2024 North Carolina Supreme Court election, which includes ballots from voters with incomplete registration records and from military and overseas voters who did not provide photo IDs, asserting that these ballots do not comply with North Carolina State election laws;

WHEREAS, election integrity is a core tenet of the Republican Party, and Judge Griffin's actions exemplify this principle; and,

WHEREAS, it is crucial for the Republican Party to stand behind its candidates and support their efforts to uphold the rule of law and ensure that every vote is legitimate; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the 3rd District of the North Carolina Republican Party expresses its full support for Judge Jefferson Griffin in his legal challenge to ensure the integrity of the 2024 North Carolina Supreme Court election;

RESOLVED, that the 3rd District of the North Carolina Republican Party commends Judge Griffin for his dedication in seeking to verify the election results, thereby reinforcing the public's trust in our democratic processes; and,

RESOLVED, that the 3rd District of the North Carolina Republican Party shall utilize media platforms to unequivocally demonstrate its full and unified support for Judge Griffin's efforts, ensuring this resolution reaches him and relevant RNC party leadership.
