Treasurer: Ken MacMillan reported on the current available funds for October 2020 is \$2,800. He identified the total amount of expenditures as \$741 with a breakdown for each item spent.

9. Fundraising Committee Report

- Fundraising committee chair, Fred Kaplan reported on the success of the Elephant Stomp reviewing the three different methods for ticket purchase, expenses, donations and preliminary net profit. Even though the weather was a deterrent to attendance of the expected 102 people, the fundraising goal was achieved. A suggestion was made to send a brief summary, via email to the 4,400 Republicans with information on the next event. The general consensus was to repeat this event next year. Pictures will be provided so they can be posted to the website.
- An update was provided on the May 16, 2020 Golfing Event by John Rebholz. To encourage \$125 sponsors, an 8X18 sign will be posted at each hole with advertising information. The same advertising rules applied to Reagan Day Dinner will be applied to all sponsors. While a business name and information can be placed on a sign, the payment must be made by an individual's check not a business account.
