 - Municipal election candidates were discussed. There were no candidates listed for Pantego and only Democrats were listed for City of Washington and Washington Park.
 The BC Board of Elections will post on its website a complete list shortly after the noon deadline of July 19, 2019
 - Discussion on how to map districts included comments on the "Pure At Large" system or
 following school district lines. The chairman thanked the participants. He further stated
 this committee had no immediate authority to influence district mapping and reminded
 them the focus of the committee is to ensure more republicans are voted into office.
 - Discussion focused on how to get the vote out and the importance of reaching out to family and friends and consideration was given to writing letters to the editor of the local newspaper.
