10:46am- Commissioner Frankie Waters spoke regarding the Beaufort County Board of Commissioners as the Chairman.

10:48am- Commissioner Stan Deathridge spoke regarding the Beaufort County Board of Commissioners.

10:50am- Convention chairman recognized all elected officials and veterans.

10:50am- Hood Richardson asked if there was an agenda that would be published and presented to the convention attendees. Convention Chair Pruett stated the agenda was published. The agenda will be printed and given to everyone that would like an agenda.

10:52am- Senator Jim Perry discussed the importance of this election.

10:56am- Hood Richardson called a Point of Order that all candidates should be able to speak. The Convention Chair said this will take place later during the convention.

10:57am- Credentials report given by Anne Maatman. Allotted number of delegates to county convention, all delegates present.

10:58am- Hood Richardson called a Point of Order that the delegates present should be read to convention attendees.

11:00am- Anne Maatman reported all delegates that were present. Final count of delegates present is 64. 33 needed for a majority vote. Super majority (2/3) will be 43.

11:06am- Rules of convention presented. Motion made by Chairman of Rules committee, Jimmie Whichard with a second by Dot Moate. Rules adopted as published.

11:07am- Elect delegates and alternates to 3rd District CD and State Convention. The delegates elected for the 3rd CD convention were recalculated.

11:11am- City Councilman Bobby Robertson spoke about what is taking place in the City of Washington.

11:16am- Anne Maatman with Credentials shared that there are 47 3rd CD delegates and we are allotted 50.

It was asked if you have to be present in order to be a delegate for the district convention. Chairman Pruett stated a letter would need to be presented. Patricia Garrison requested to be added although she is not present today. She will be added. Steve Rader moved for an adoption of the delegation list. Seconded by Frankie Waters.

Parliamentarian requested that the vote be counted by individuals standing.

There were 37 voting in favor of making an amendment to the agenda to allow candidates to speak. Candidates present will be given two minutes to speak.

11:49am- Convention Chairman asked for any additional resolutions. Hood Richardson spoke on his resolution on Unaffiliated Voters. His resolution reads as follows:

"Individuals registered as UNAFFILIATED not be invited to vote in the 2022 Republican primary elections. This resolution to be presented at the Third District and State Republican Party conventions."

The Convention Chairman spoke regarding this resolution.

Hood Richardson made the motion with Keith Kidwell and John Rebholz as a second.

Jackie Van Essdendelft spoke in opposition of the resolution.

Keith Kidwell spoke for the resolution.

Dot Moate spoke in opposition of the resolution.

Stan Deatheridge spoke for the resolution.

Discussion is closed at this time.

There are 38 voted in favor to pass the resolution. The resolution passed.

Chairman Pruett asked for permission to reword the resolution and Hood Richardson approved Chairman Pruett to reword the resolution as he finds necessary.
