## Resolution to Update the Definition of "Written Notice" In the NCGOP Plan of Organization

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Republican Party Plan of Organization, effective as of the date of this Resolution, defines the term "Written Notice" in Section I, paragraph 1, page 39;

WHEREAS, "Written Notice" refers to first class mail of the United States Postal Service;

WHEREAS, technology advances have enabled the common use of additional written electronic communication channels, offering greater reliability and speed at a lower cost than first class mail; and

**WHEREAS**, taking advantage of such electronic channels calls for an update of the NCGOP Plan of Organization; therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, NCGOP Plan of Organization, Section I, paragraph 1, page 39 (shown immediately below and indented) below be change as follows (additions in red, deletions are red hashmarks):

- I. NOTICE
- 1. Written Notice

"Written Notice" as used in this plan shall mean notice sent through the United States Postal Service (USPS) first class mail, electronic mail, or text message. Any method will be considered official notification from the NCGOP, District, County, or Precinct, provided the sender is an authorized communications agent, and the message is identified with the following tag - "This is an official communication from the NCGOP, or respective District, County, or Precinct".

- a. The date post marked by the USPS or electronic service shall be conclusive as to the date notice was given.
- b. Individuals entitled to receive notice under this plan may elect to receive notification by other means in lieu of written notice. This may be requested via written notice to the secretary of the entity required to give written notice; however, this waiver is revocable at any time by sending written notice of the revocation to the secretary.
