WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION -

I've been involved in the lives are children for years. I was first area of ministry was working in Children's Church. I have 4 kids and soon to be 6 Grandchildren. I'm have been involved in Church Youth Camp, and Vacation Bible School. I have served in a local Boy Scout Troop, and on a Christian School Board here in Hillsborough. I mention all this because there comes a time when two kids see things differently. Not too different than where our divided Country is currently. You have heard kids say, "That's not fair."

We believe in fairness. Everyone should be treated fairly. One of the pillars of our Republic is equal justice under the law. Another important idea is the "rule of law." The rule of law means that everyone must obey the law, and no one is above the law. This means that the government and its leaders must also obey the law. As conservatives we believe, uphold, and defend that standard.

We have seen for years the Weaponizing the Judiciary. Whether it was Eric Holder carrying the water for the Obama Administration, Loretta Lynch working with Hilary Clinton Campaign and FBI Director James Comey to tip the scales. I'm not going to bring up the shortcomings of Merrick Garland.

A judge in July 2016 blocked a North Carolina law that required voters to produce photo identification, and is said to be disproportionately affecting minorities, finding that the law was intended to make it harder for blacks. When 68% of voters believe in Voter ID. We have argued that an unelected Judge blocked Voter Rights in NC. Which brings us to events of the last week.

- 1) Trump was indicted in a NYC courtroom Where a weak case that has been passed on by FEC, and Special Council Robert Mueller. The wealth and breath of legal discovery against Donald Trump is tragic that an activist DA, who campaigned to, "Get Trump," can bring such a sad case. There may be 2 more cases brought. The question is, are these cases going forward in the name of Justice, or Trump Delusion Syndrome.
- **2) Abortion Pill -** A US District Court Judge in Texas, a Trump appointee, ruled that Mifepristone should be blocked. The ruling centers around the thought that the FDA went beyond its authority when it approved the medication. Lawyers also argued that a 19th century anti-obscenity law, the Comstock Act, prohibits the mailing of any medication used for abortion. A Dueling ruling in WA state is the opposite end of the spectrum

of the Abortion issue. A Federal Judge on Friday ordered U.S. authorities not to make any changes that would restrict access to the abortion medication in 17 Democratic-led states that sued over the issue, countering a ruling by a judge in Texas on the same day that ordered a hold on federal approval of the drug. The dueling decisions threw into question access to the nation's most common method of abortion. Due to this, the Sunday Morning talk shows were all over the Left's side of the argument. Everything in the table including the secretary of HHS Chief Xavier Becerra possibly ignoring the ban. Democrat members in congress are calling to ignore ruling too. AOC says it's an abuse of power. Could FDA ignore a court's ruling? Dems decried the Trump administration for what they said was ignoring the law when the tables were reversed. The conflicting orders will go to SCOTUS.

3) The Tennessee 3 - 2 of whom have been expelled from the Legislature during debate after the Nashville school shooting, for not following the decorum of the chamber. Kamala Harris complains about the ousted TN legislators shows how noisy Left can get. But when Conservatives gather to protest, it's an insurrection.

Elections have Consequences — The Easter Bunny came early this year to the NC Legislature, as former a Democrat NC House Member switched parties. Rep. Tricia Cotham, of 112 district in Mecklenburg County became a Republican. Now the Republican party hold the 72 seats required in the 120-seat House chamber to hold a veto-proof majority. Republicans had already held 30 of the 50 seats in the Senate needed to override vetoes if party members are present and voting, but until Wednesday, they were one seat shy of a similar advantage in the House following the November elections. There is also a Conservative Majority on the Sate Supreme Court. So many bills that come forward this session that can be vetoed by Democrat Governor Roy Cooper, and go back thorough the chambers and pass. The State Budget, Abortion restrictions, Voting Maps, Gender questions, and other laws are now controlled by the Republican caucus.

voters can be assured their vote counts. During the recent 2022 elections, we trained 60 Poll Observers to sit and watch the election process. These are important jobs, but observing across a room is not as vital as being behind the seat in the voting enclosure. Unfortunately we do not have enough Republicans and like minded Unaffiliated voters who can have the best view of the process. We are looking for conservatives who can serve a two year term as **Election Judges** and **Poll Workers** inside all 40 Election Precincts. Workers are paid on a scale in accordance to the Orange County employees wage scale. Orange County Board of Elections provides training. Getting involved now helps us when we retake the Governors Mansion in 2024, that we can have trained Judges in all Orange County Precincts, and more opportunity to have trained Chief Judges in all Voting sites beginning in 2025. The term runs from August 2023 to June 2025, and entails the possibilities of working the Municipal Elections this fall, the Primaries next March, any runoff elections and of course the Presidential Election in November 2024.
