# **Spotlight on Martha Jenkins**

Martha Jenkins first got involved in Orange County politics in the fall of 1994 when she joined the Republican Women's Club of Chapel Hill. Thanks to the leadership of then club president, Jo Barbour of Hillsborough, Martha also started going to Orange County GOP meetings the next year. She has served as county chair, district chair and state GOP secretary. She has also been chief judge of her precinct for 10 years or more.



Martha served as the president of the North Carolina Federation of Republican Women from 2003-2007. Since then she has been on the National Federation of Republican Women Executive Committee for four terms and is now the slated candidate to be the next President of NFRW. The Convention where the election will take place is in Orlando September 25-28. The campaign will involve purchasing ads, hosting a reception and other candidate materials.
