LIFELONG RESIDENT OF ROCKINGHAM COUNTY

1985 Joined the United States Air Force. Graduated with honor from Air Force Military Training Academy

1989 Honorably discharged as member of the Air Force Security Police as Sergeant
Returned to Rockingham County and completed Basic Law Enforcement Training

1990 Joined Reidsville Police Dept and served in the Patrol Division answering calls from Wrecks to homicides. One of only 4 officers selected to serve on the Agency's First Narcotic Drug Interdiction Team

1994 Moved to the Rockingham County Sheriff's Department until retirement in 2014 after a 30-year career

Started as Deputy Sheriff in the Patrol Division working as Field Office Training

Parker rose to the rank of Lieutenant and was promoted to Patrol Captain

Moved to Captain over Criminal Investigations

Worked closely with DEA, ATF, NCSBI, as well as local police departments

Parker attended numerous trainings including DEA Law Enforcement Training, Leadership Training, Police Law Institute Training

Obtained Advanced Law Enforcement Certificate

Earned an Associate Degree in Law Enforcement Technology Captain of Criminal Investigation Division

Returned to work as Rockingham County/Caswell County In the District Attorney's Office as Investigator

2023 Sheriff Parker formed an official Committee to seek office
