- His background as a **two-time Durham Public Schools Teacher of the Year** and public school leader provides a deep understanding of community needs, particularly concerning youth.
- His entrepreneurial success as co-founder of **Zweli's**, the first full-service authentic Zimbabwean restaurant in the United States with his wife, is a remarkable feat.
- The expansion to **three restaurants in Durham** "intentionally providing jobs for residents" highlights his commitment to economic development and local employment.
- He's the only elected official in Durham city and county that has to make a payroll every two weeks.

5. Recognition Among Mayoral Peers:

- His inclusion as an inaugural Hunt Institute Mayor and a Bloomberg Mayor signifies recognition of his leadership and innovative approaches by influential national organizations.
- His membership in the exclusive New Deal Mayors, focusing on bipartisan approaches, and his newly elected position on the African American Mayors
 Association board of trustees, further solidify his standing as a respected leader among his counterparts.
- His leading role on the Economic and Workforce Development commission at the
 United States Conference of Mayors and membership in the United States
 Roundtable of Mayors underscore his influence in shaping national urban policy
 discussions.

The Durham City Council, particularly over the last two years (roughly 2023-2025), has focused on a range of initiatives aimed at community safety, economic development, infrastructure, and social equity. While Mayor Leonardo Williams took office in December 2023, the accomplishments of the council reflect the collective efforts during this period, often with Mayor Williams playing a key role as a council member and then as Mayor.

Top Accomplishments of the Durham City Council under Mayor Williams' leadership:

- Significant Budget Approvals with Focus on Community Needs: The Council has approved substantial budgets, including the recent \$772 million plan for the 2025-2026 fiscal year. These budgets prioritize key areas:
 - Community Safety: Expanding programs like the HEART (Holistic Engagement and Response Team) response team by adding 17 full-time staff. They also support programs like the Durham Expunction and Restoration (DEAR) Program (helping residents clear criminal charges and restore driver's licenses) and the Eviction Diversion Program to prevent homelessness.
 - **Employee Support:** Increasing pay to remain competitive and raising the **minimum livable wage for City workers** from \$19.58 to \$21.90 per hour.
 - **Service Delivery:** Keeping GoDurham buses **fare-free through June 2026** and investing \$17 million in expanding bus service. They also allocated \$500,000 for **Vision Zero safety work** to reduce deadly crashes.
- **Major Infrastructure Investments:** The Council has committed significant funds to essential infrastructure upgrades, often leveraging voter-approved bonds:
 - Water and Sewer Systems: Allocating \$315.7 million for upgrades, including work on the Jordan Lake Water Treatment Plant.
 - **Stormwater Improvements:** Dedicating \$25.7 million for stormwater improvements and flood reduction, including the South Ellerbe Restoration project.
 - Parks and Recreation: Adding \$7 million for lead soil cleanup at five parks (East Durham, East End, Lyon, Northgate, Walltown). Funding major Connect Durham bond projects such as a new \$43 million aquatic center at Merrick-Moore Park and a \$42 million project to connect Long Meadow and East End parks.
 - Streets and Sidewalks: Significantly increasing funding for street repaving (\$25 million, up from \$15 million) and sidewalk repairs (\$10 million, up from \$2 million) through the \$115 million Connect Durham bond.
- Strategic Planning and Policy Creation: The City Council adopted the FY24-FY26 Strategic Plan in June 2023, which outlines five key goals: Shared Economic Prosperity, Creating a Safer Community Together, Connected, Engaged, and Inclusive Communities, Innovative and High-Performing Organization, and Thriving and Vibrant Environment. This plan serves as a guiding vision for transforming the growing city. The Council has also led on the creation of significant policies that positively impact the quality of life in Durham.
- **Affordable Housing and Development:** The Council has continued to address the critical need for affordable housing, with discussions and approvals for incomerestricted apartment units. While specific projects can sometimes be debated, the overall goal of increasing housing options remains a priority. For example, they

recently approved substantial amendments to housing plans to address urgent community needs.

These accomplishments highlight the Durham City Council's commitment to strategic investment, community well-being, and progressive policy-making over the past two years.
