Pursuant to Article XIII, Section D, paragraph 2 of the Bylaws of the Colorado Republican State Central Committee and Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-4-102 and § 1-4-601, notice is hereby given that the **4th Congressional District Republican Assembly** shall be convened beginning at **9:30 A.M.** on **Friday, April 10, 2026** at the **Colorado State University-Pueblo Campus in the Occhiato Student Center Ballroom, located at 2200 Bonforte Blvd, Pueblo, CO 81001.**

Check-in and credentialing for this assembly will begin at 8:00 A.M. Due to facility limitations, alternate delegates will remain outside the meeting hall and will only be allowed in the meeting room as they are called up to be seated.

A total of **621 delegates** have been authorized by the 4th Congressional District Republican Central Committee for this Assembly. Delegates have been apportioned to each county according to the STATE DELEGATE APPORTIONMENT METHOD/FORMULA (according to the votes cast in the 2024 for the Republican candidate for President in each county) as follows:
