Amendment proposed by Andrew Braddock

Omit (3) and (4), and substitute:

- (3) Calls on the ACT Government to:
- (a) Adopt free public transport for concession card holders as a form of cost-of-living relief for those who are in the greatest need;
 - (b) Seek federal funding to enable the provision of:
 - i) free public transport for the duration of the fuel supply crisis;
 - ii) 50 cent fares beyond the period of the crisis; and
 - iii) an uplift in investment in public and active transport assets and infrastructure;
- (4) Calls on all members, through their party leaders where relevant, to write to the Prime Minister to advocate for the implementation of a 25% tax on gas exports, to shift the cost burden for these reforms away from the average Australian and towards those profiting from this fuel supply shock.
