NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF SERVICE APPROVAL
Section 73, *Education and Care Services National Law Act (ACT)*

As a delegate of the ACT Regulatory Authority, Children's Education and Care Assurance, I notify you that the approval for Genius Gungahlin SE-40001554, is suspended. The suspension will take effect **from the date of this notice.**

A written decision setting out the evidence and reasons for the suspension is included with this notice.

Effect of Suspension

Period of suspension – 5 March 2025 to 5 May 2025 (Inclusive)
Date on which it takes effect – 5 March 2025.

A suspension of a service approval also suspends the service approval to the extent that it relates to an associated children's service.

Notice to parents of cancellation

Under Section 84 of the *National Law*, I require you to give written notice of the suspension of the service approval and its effect to parents of all children enrolled at Genius Gungahlin SE-40001554.

Failure to comply with this requirement can result in a penalty of \$3,400 in the case of an individual or \$17,200 in any other case. In your notice to parents, you may wish to direct your families to www.mychild.gov.au for education and care alternatives.

Right to external review

Under section 193 of the National Law, you may apply for an external review of this decision with the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal. An application must be lodged within 30 days after you are notified of the decision or become aware of the decision. An application can be completed and printed from <http://www.acat.act.gov.au>. Service's record of compliance

Details of this suspension must be recorded in the service's record of compliance including: the reason the suspension was undertaken and the period of the suspension. The information must not identify any person other than the approved provider.

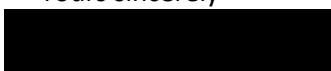
The information does not need to be recorded until after the period for applying for external review has expired.
