

Email Subject: Vote NO to Prop. 2024/25:124 – Protect Digital Rights, Freedom of Speech and Sex Workers' Safety

I'm writing to express my strong opposition to [Proposition 2024/25:124](#), and in particular **the proposal to criminalise the purchase of sexual acts performed remotely, such as through webcamming and digital content creation (Chapter 6, pp. 28–38).**

This proposal will not protect vulnerable individuals. Instead, it will:

- Increase surveillance and policing of online communication
- Create legal uncertainty and vague enforcement thresholds
- Undermine freedom of expression and constitutional rights
- Disproportionately harm women, LGBTQI+ people, migrants, and people with disabilities
- Criminalise consensual digital labour

Human rights defenders, sex workers and content creators across Sweden and Europe have spoken out: digital work is a lifeline, especially for those facing marginalisation or exclusion from other sectors. Taking this away without offering meaningful alternatives increases harm.

I support targeted, rights-based responses to exploitation, not blanket criminalisation that punishes workers and weakens democratic protections.

Here you can find a [joint statement and campaign](#) signed by over 1,500 civil rights organisations, including feminist and digital rights organisations, human rights experts, and academics globally, calling for the rejection of this law proposal.

I hope you will stand with evidence, with rights, and with dignity, and **vote NO** on this proposal on the **20th May**.
