10-module online FASD Training for Educators



FASD-CAN.org.nz presents a practical, evidence-based training course on Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder for educators in Aotearoa NZ.

The course will enable educators at every level to implement strategies for FASD that work in a 'real-world' setting of limited resources and competing demands. Our aim is to enable kaiako and support staff to understand and address the unique needs of these neurodiverse learners.

There will be ten modules delivered fortnightly online over 3 terms in 2026. Sessions are 1.5 hours long every

second Thursday presented by three FASD-informed experts in education.
