Online FASD Training for Learning Support Coordinators (LSCs)

FASD-CAN offers a practical training course on Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder for Learning Support Coordinators (LSCs) in Aotearoa NZ.

This course will teach brain-based strategies for ākongā / learners with FASD that work in a 'real-world' setting. LSCs will gain an understanding of the needs of these students using brain-based, trauma-informed learnings.

There are 10 learning modules, two Community of Practice discussion sessions, and an extra Masterclass with three excellent topic options.

Sessions are 1.5 hours long, delivered via Zoom in term time, and presented by three FASD-informed experts in inclusive education.
