ABOUT THE PRIZE

The \$2,000 prize recognises work in legal assistance sector that supports the promotion of human rights and justice for socially and economically disadvantaged people in Victoria. The Trustees welcome nominations that reflect collaborative and networked initiatives. Nominations must address at least one of the following criteria:

COMMUNITY LEGAL EDUCATION & LAW REFORM - Achievement in law reform and/or community legal education activities that protect and promote human rights and justice for socially disadvantaged people and communities in Victoria.

LEGAL AID SERVICE DELIVERY - Outstanding contribution to the protection and promotion of human rights and justice for people and communities in Victoria through community legal service delivery.

ADVOCACY - Outstanding achievement in advocacy of human rights and justice for socially and economically disadvantaged people and communities in Victoria.

HOW TO NOMINATE

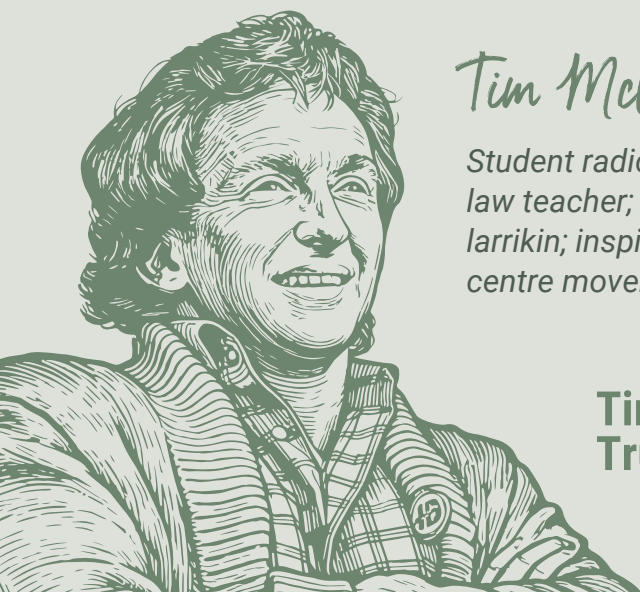
To nominate an individual and/or project, **scan the QR code**.
