## 1. Climate Risk Guidelines for Canada's Banks

OSFI - the Office of the Superintendent of Financial Institutions - has drafted guidelines intended to make Canada's banks take climate change seriously, and they've been getting all kinds of reaction from Canadians about how lame the guidelines are. OSFI isn't used to hearing from a lot of people outside the financial community, and every person they hear from intensifies that pressure. You can be sure they are hearing the opposite view from Canada's big five banks, who have been making incredible profits from investing more than \$900 billion in fossil fuel projects that endanger the client and violate Indigenous rights.

## 2. Cutting Emissions from the Oil & Gas Industry
