The original 1975 Charter of Rights.

1. The Right to be defended against the Country's enemies
2. The Right to live under The Queen's Peace
3. Freedom of movement
4. Freedom of religion and worship
5. Freedom of speech and publication
6. Freedom of assembly and association for lawful purpose
7. Freedom to withdraw one's labour other than contrary to public safety
8. Freedom to belong or not to belong to a trade union or employer's association
9. The Right to private ownership
10. The Right to dispose or convey property by deed or will
11. Freedom to exercise choice or personal priority in spending and from oppressive taxation
12. Freedom from all coercive monopolies
13. Freedom to engage in private enterprise
14. Freedom of choice in the use of state or private education and medicine
15. The Right to protection from the invasion of privacy


