OCTOBER 14 REFERENDUM WHAT YOU ARE VOTING ON

If Australians vote in favour of the Voice, the Constitution would be amended to add the following words

In recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the First Peoples of Australia:

- There shall be a body, to be called the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice;
- The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice may make representations to the Parliament and the Executive Government of the Commonwealth on matters relating to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples;

The Parliament shall, subject to this Constitution, have power to make laws with respect to matters relating to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice, including its composition, functions, powers and procedures.



HOW WILL THE VOICE WORK?



The Voice would be an advisory committee of Indigenous people from all around our country that can give advice to politicians in Canberra to improve the lives of Indigenous people.

When Parliament or the Government want to improve outcomes for Indigenous Australians in areas like health and education, they'd ask the Voice to come up with the best solutions that will actually work and make a real, practical difference for Indigenous people and communities.

Parliament and Government can choose to listen to that advice, or not - and ultimately make the final decision.

It's a simple and practical way that together, we can create a better future for all Australians.
