

Petition to the House of Commons

We, the undersigned citizens of Canada, draw the attention of the House of Commons to the following:

Whereas, the Chinese Communist Party covered up the dangers of COVID-19 during its initial response – silencing doctors and whistleblowers who tried to warn the public; and,

Whereas, the Chinese Communist Party is also exploiting this current global crisis to intensify its assault on the rights of its own citizens, including: Hong Kongers, Uyghur Muslims, Chinese Christians, Tibetans, and Falun Gong practitioners; and,

Whereas, the Chinese Communist Party's recent threat of "continuous harm" to Canada in reaction to the B.C. Supreme Court’s hearing of Huawei Executive Meng Wanzhou is part of a pattern of global bullying by the Chinese Communist Party; and,

Whereas, the Liberal government has been weak in its response to this threat and has been putting Canadians at risk, choosing instead to spend hundreds of millions of dollars of taxpayers’ money in funding the “Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank”, which is controlled by Beijing and seeks to spread the Chinese Communist Party’s influence through infrastructure projects throughout Asia and Africa; and,

Whereas, it has recently been exposed that Canada’s Foreign Affairs Minister, François-Philippe Champagne, owes the Bank of China more than \$1 million in mortgages, raising serious conflict of interest concerns;

Therefore we, the undersigned, call on the House of Commons to allow the Special Committee on Canada-China Relations to reconvene and thoroughly examine all aspects of our relationship with China.
