Why should I get involved?

Specifically, we hope the mentee will:

- Be prepared to share and discuss educational, career or research objectives
- Allow the mentor to introduce you to his/her colleagues with similar interests
- Invite the mentor to attend your poster or podium presentation of the mentee and seek his/her feedback
