
## **Proposal**

Proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment to permit a mixed-use development consisting of tall (21 and 25 storeys) and mid-rise (6 and 11 storeys) components.

A total of 658 residential units are proposed for 41,000 square metres of residential floor space, as well as 1,900 square metres of flexible studio space, and 1,500 square metres of commercial space. A total of 330 underground parking spaces are proposed with access from Milky Way Lane.
