Resolutions

A. Hidalgo County - Palestine Resolution 3/16/24 - withdrawn

We, the Green Party of Texas, call for an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Palestine. We call upon Democrats and Republican party organizations of Texas to stand against genocide at all times and in every place and also pass a resolution calling for a permanent ceasefire in Palestine.

B. Hidalgo County - Permian Basin Resolution 3/16/24 - approved by consensus

The Green Party of Texas calls for state and federal officials / government agencies to coordinate a fact-finding mission and true assessment on the contamination of freshwater sources in the Permian Basin. These are the areas most at risk:

Counties: Ward, Pecos, Crane, Reeves

Aquifers: The Rustler, The Santa Rosa, The Pecos Valley Alluvial

Rivers: Pecos

C. Hidalgo County - Green Jay Park & Mission Bike Trails Resolution 3/16/24 - approved by consensus

The Green Party of Texas calls on Hidalgo County and the city of McAllen to save Green Jay Park, to protect and expand public spaces and green spaces, and to oppose any deal that would expand a firing range and shut down a public trail. We propose that the firing range be closed, and the trail expanded, if the two cannot safely coexist.

D. Harris County - Resolution for a Permanent Ceasefire in Gaza 3/16/24 - approved by consensus

Whereas the Israeli Occupation Forces have directly slain at least 30,000 Palestinian non-combatants since October 2023;

Whereas the Israeli Occupation Forces have actively interfered with delivery of food and medical supplies to afflicted populations; and

Whereas the United States continues to aid and abet genocidal actions committed by the government of Israel against the people of Gaza,

Therefore be it resolved that the Green Party of Texas calls for an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Gaza and the occupied Palestinian territories, calls for an end to the occupation of Palestine, and supports the right of the Palestinian people to self-determination;

Be it further resolved that the US government must use all available means to compel Israel to permit the delivery of humanitarian aid to Gaza and must immediately end all military aid to Israel.

E. Harris County - Resolution for the Right of Prisoners to Vote 3/16/24 - approved by consensus

The Harris County Green Party and the Green Party of Texas resolve that we support the right of prisoners to vote as stated in the Green Party of the United States platform, copied below.

H. Criminal Justice, Green Solutions, 2. Prison Conditions, Prisoner Treatment and Parolees, g:

Provide incarcerated individuals the right to vote by absentee ballot in the district of their domicile, and the right to vote during parole.
