## Green Party

First Introduced in 2009

100% Renewable Energy by 2030

Elimination of Fossil Fuels by 2030

Breaks from dangerous for-profit nuclear Industry

Transition to Public Ownership of Energy Industry

Green New Deal Workplaces cooperatively-run by workers

End Wars for Oil and Redirect 50% of Military Spending

20 Million New Jobs

Comprehensive Medicare-for-All bill like HR676

## Democratic Party

First Introduced in 2019

Claims 100% renewable energy by 2030 but revised language to “clean” energy

No clear timetable for elimination of fossil fuels, contradicting original intended goal

Leaves door open to for-profit nuclear industry

Public subsidizing the same for-profit energy industry that finances deregulation and oil dependency

Workplaces largely owned and managed by the same energy industry

Military Complex and financial incentive for Wars unchallenged.

“Millions” of Jobs

Expanded healthcare w/ unclear timetable for elimination of insurance industry
