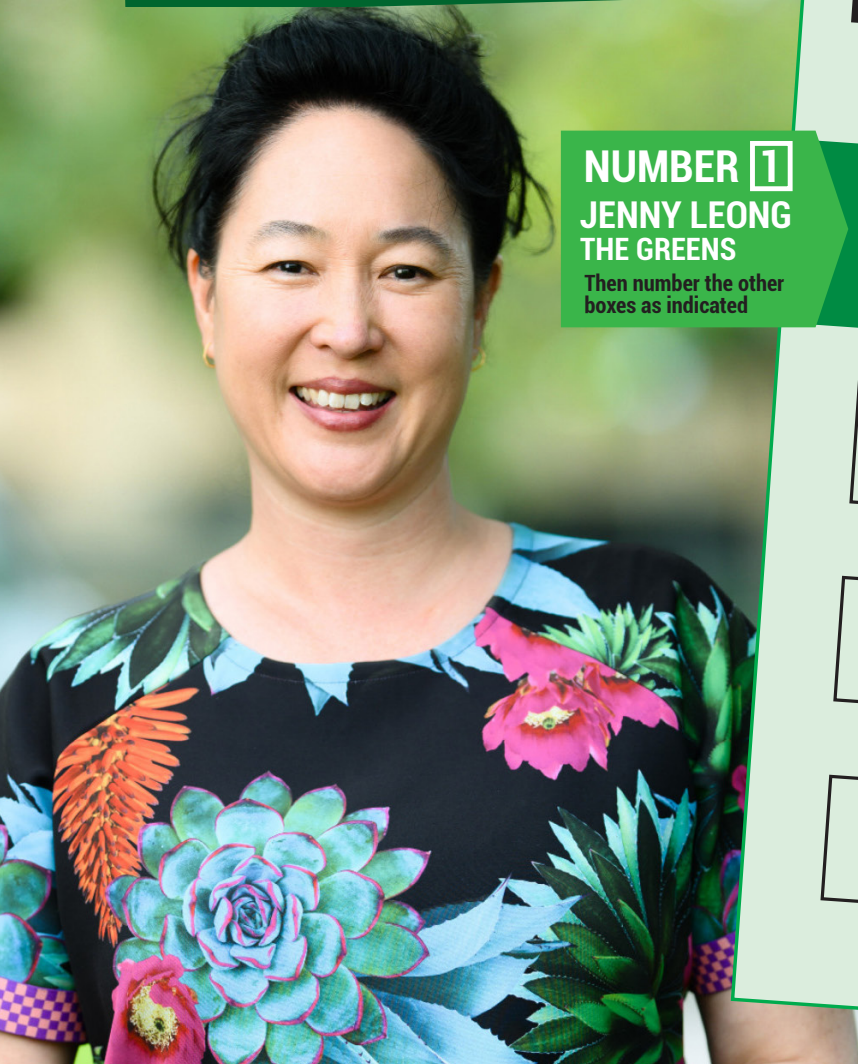

WE'VE HELPED DELIVER:

- ▲ Accessibility upgrades for 5 local train stations
- ▲ A safe and open Newtown vibe when lockout laws threatened night life across the city
- ▲ Direct support for public housing tenants facing maintenance and other issues
- ▲ Hundreds of thousands of dollars in infrastructure for 53 local organisations through the Community Building Partnership Grants program

CLIMATE ACTION

- ▲ End coal and gas by 2030
- ▲ Transition to 100% renewable public energy

- ▲ Immediately freeze rents, ban unfair evictions and introduce rent controls
- ▲ Massive investment in public, social and affordable homes
