## General Membership Meeting MEETING MINUTES March 20, 2012 7:00 - 9:00pm

**Location: San Francisco Women's Building** 

- 1) General Membership (GM) Meeting was called to order by President Anna Conda at 7:15pm
- 2) Announcements
  - I. Official PAC recommendations are available at table. Please ignore falsified statement using the Harvey Milk Democratic Club name.
  - II. Jane Martin representing POWER made a brief presentation on free MUNI for San Francisco youth. Both the Board of Supervisors and SF Unified School District have endorsed free MUNI for youth. Identified funding source from Supervisor Campos; SFMTA is deciding whether to adopt the policy. Requesting in name support for free MUNI for youth from HMDC.
    - Motion for HMDC to support free MUNI for youth was passed unanimously.
  - III. On April 5<sup>th</sup>, HMDC will attend City College Queer Rec Center to do DCCC slate outreach. Bringing literature and leading a brief discussion. Will be led by President Anna Conda, a student at CCSF.
    - Jamie Rafaela Wolf, representing TransMarch, announced a fundraiser on April 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm at Buck Tavern. Requested co-sponsorship (in name) of the event. Last year, the Trans March provided a trolley for those unable to walk. This year, they would like to provide two trolleys.
    - Motion for HMDC to co-sponsor (in name) the Trans March fundraiser on April 17<sup>th</sup> was passed unanimously.
  - IV. Laura Thomas announced that the federal government step off medical marijuana prosecution in support of Tom Ammiano's cannabis bill. There will be a rally on April 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the basement of the state building in Sacramento.

Gabriel Halland announced that on April 11<sup>th</sup> there will be a community briefing about as needed workers who work for the City and County of San Francisco. As-needed workers need raises and union membership. Request for HMDC to support as-needed workers.

Motion for HMDC to support as-needed CCSF workers at the April 11<sup>th</sup> meeting passed unanimously.

#### Statewide Initiatives:

### **Proposition 28: Limits on Legislators' Terms in Office**

Reduces the total amount of time a person may serve in the state legislature from 14 years to 12 years. Allows a person to serve a total of 12 years either in the Assembly, the Senate, or a combination of both.
