Janice Li and Arturo Peredes Transit Panel

- Janice Li
 - Rode Muni during campaigning, is a regular Muni rider, rides Muni to work.
 - Navigating city with public transit is the best way to discover the city
 - Transporting advocacy world is very white and privileged as opposed to public transportation riders
 - You don't need to be an expert to champion transportation policy
 - Panels on transport policy must include non-policy experts, riders, should discuss transit and be a part of policy making.
 - Deconstruct what public safety means and stop defining policing based on what white people think safety means. Make public transport safe for POC and trans folks.
 - Push the bounds of what public transportation means.
 - Advocates need to be rider focused. Stop thinking black and brown folks as hypotheticals, and need to talk to people on the ground.
 - POC should get involved in advocacy by being a part of meetings and conversations accessible to the public.
 - 65% of the operating budget was from fares vs. Low teens for MUNI which depends on general funds for budget. COVID proved

- challenges. We need to tax the wealthy to support the budget so that public transport is not dependent on ridership fares. Public Bank formation, Prop 13 reform should be funding the budget.
- Doesn't understand why MUNI is not running at 100% even though there's federal funding- we must understand the complications and advocate for answers and push for recovery. Austerity measures will be disastrous.
- BART is taking 50% off BART fares for September, not much but BART has never done anything like it before but it is a start.
- Milk Club should work with Bike coalition organizers (eg. Clare, SomCAN) as well as Poder-- avenues to make change.

Arturo Peredes

- We must tax the rich to fund Free Muni.
- Free MUNI will make public transport more equitable.
- Way to encourage ridership would be to educate people, highlight the benefits
- We must modernize our public transportation system, make it more inviting for riders.
- Public input is important.
- Advocacy is important to pass Free Muni (Poder, Youth Mojo etc)
- Milk Club members should join the advocacy coalition for free MUNI.
- There should be a campaign in the city to encourage people to take public transportation.
