



Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") applies to Membership Application, and HAWAII ISLAND RENTAL PROPERTY ALLIANCE ("Organization") and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Organization include www.hirpa.org. The Organization's application is a Membership application. By using the Organization application, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better represent you with accurate data and reporting, the Organization may ask you for personally identifiable information, such as your:

The Organization may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

- Age

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services. These may include: (a) registering for an account; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties if offered; (d) sending us an email message. To wit, we will ONLY use your information for creating generalized reporting for advocacy efforts or communicating with you in relation to necessary bills or meetings that affect you and which you have requested notifications from us. We also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Use of your Personal Information

The Organization collects and uses your personal information in the following ways:

- to operate and deliver the content you have requested
- to provide you with information or advocacy efforts that you request from us
- to provide you with notices about your account
- to carry out the Organization's obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered between you and us, including for billing and collection
- to notify you about changes to our Membership Application or any products or services we offer or provide through it



- in any other way we may describe when you provide the information
- for any other purpose with your consent.

The Organization may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other legislation or issues arising from the Organization and HIMAST.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

The Organization does not sell, rent, or lease its customer lists to third parties.

The Organization may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to the Organization, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

The Organization may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on the Organization or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of the Organization; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of the Organization, or the public.

Right to Deletion

Subject to certain exceptions set out below, on receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will:

- Delete your personal information from our records; and
- Direct any service providers to delete your personal information from their records.

Please note that we may not be able to comply with requests to delete your personal information if it is necessary to:

- Complete the transaction for which the personal information was collected, or maintain the membership between you and us;
- Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity; or prosecute those responsible for that activity;
- Debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality;
- Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law;
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act;
- Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when our deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, provided we have obtained your informed consent;
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us;



- Comply with an existing legal obligation; or
- Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information.

Children Under Thirteen

The Organization does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13. If you are under the age of 13, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this application.

Email Communications

From time to time, the Organization may contact you via email for the purpose of providing announcements, testimony alerts, hearing notifications, surveys, and/or other general communication. In order to improve our services, we may receive a notification when you open an email from the Organization or click on a link therein.

If you would like to stop receiving marketing or promotional communications via email from the Organization, you may opt out of such communications by Selecting the Opt-out link in each message.

External Data Storage Sites

We may store your data on servers provided by third-party hosting vendors with whom we have contracted.

Changes to This Statement

The Organization reserves the right to change this Policy from time to time. For example, when there are changes in our services, changes in our data protection practices, or changes in the law. When changes to this Policy are significant, we will inform you. You may receive a notice by sending an email to the primary email address specified in your account, by placing a prominent notice on our HAWAII ISLAND RENTAL PROPERTY ALLIANCE, and/or by updating any privacy information. Your continued use of the application and/or services available after such modifications will constitute your: (a) acknowledgment of the modified Policy; and (b) agreement to abide and be bound by that Policy.
