ACTIVITY

No jumping or rough play and no bathing for 14 days. Please keep male cats indoors for at least 3 days. Please keep female cats indoors for at least 10 days.

PAIN MEDICATION

Cats receive injectable pain medication in the hospital and usually do not require additional pain medication at home. Please call us if your cat seems excessively uncomfortable.

DO NOT GIVE ANY ADDITIONAL PAIN MEDICATION WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF A VETERINARIAN. MANY HUMAN PAIN MEDICATIONS ARE HIGHLY TOXIC TO CATS.

FOOD AND WATER

Give food and water to your cat when you get home.

SURGERY SITE

Please check the incision once a day. If it appears red, painful, oozing or open, please call the clinic. No suture removal is necessary.

Do NOT allow your pet to lick excessively at the surgery site. Your pet has been given a no-lick collar (aka E-Collar) to prevent it from licking the area. We recommend male cats wear the collar for 3 days and female cats for 10 days. You may need to remove the collar for eating/drinking. Additional collars can be purchased from the Humane Society Clinic for \$5.

The clinic is normally open Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 7am-4pm. The clinic is closed on weekends. Please note there is no veterinary care available outside of clinic hours of operation.
