





Message from the

Chairman and President & CEO

Our Annual Report shows in vivid pictures, descriptive charts, powerful words and compelling facts the accomplishments of the International Eye Foundation. But the most powerful images and words cannot fully convey the impact of our services on people in developing countries. A contingent of IEF Directors gained new insight to the importance of our mission a few months ago when visiting our partner clinic, *Visualiza*, in Guatemala City, and a satellite clinic in rural Peten.

As our delegation toured the *Visualiza* clinic we met with doctors, medical technicians, business managers and staff. Many of these talented professionals have been associated with IEF for years; they are truly part of the IEF family. We were struck by their sense of purpose and dedication. It was clear: for these professionals, delivering quality eye care is a personal commitment, not a job. In fact, the doctors of *Visualiza* are so passionate about their calling they created the clinic in Peten, a farming area X miles from the city. Each doctor volunteers to move to this rural location, on a rotating basis, for a week a month, taking eye care to people who otherwise could not spend the time or expense to travel to Guatemala city. During our visit, the waiting rooms of both clinics were filled with patients who were confident they would receive the best care, even if they could not afford to pay the full price.

Medical skill and determined commitment are essential, but in developing countries with vast needs, there is a premium on efficiency, productivity and management expertise. IEF is unique in its focus on this component of eye care. Our approach, SightReach® Management, introduces business planning and management practices to clinic and hospital administration. At *Visualiza* and 13 other partners in Latin America, Asia, Africa and the Middle East, we have seen the positive results over the past 10 years: more patients treated, more cataracts removed, resources used more efficiently, and greater income has been realized. Our goal is to replicate the success of *Visualiza* and its sister institutions. We aim to add 10 clinics and hospitals to our global network by 2012. We need your support to reach this objective.

But new challenges have emerged. Cataract remains the cause of half the world's blindness. Glaucoma, retinal diseases, and refractive error are threatening the vision of greater numbers of people. By combining quality medical care and SightReach® Management principles, we are confident the incidence of these conditions will be reduced significantly. 

SightReach® Prevention

Childhood Blindness

Most eye clinics in developing countries lack pediatric ophthalmologists who can treat eye problems unique to infants and children. IEF builds capacity and infrastructure to ensure long term quality services for children who are at risk of blindness.



With support from the USAID funded "Child Blindness and Health Grants Fund", IEF is screening children in 60 schools, and outreach programs reach people in 60 communities so that people with poor vision get examined and are provided with spectacles.



Saving Sight for a Lifetime

Roberto Carlos can see thanks to Dr. Mariano Yee and Dr. Edwin Arias, the new pediatric ophthalmologist at Visualiza in Guatemala. Born with congenital cataracts, Roberto was only 28 days old when he was first examined. At age 3 months, he became Visualiza's youngest patient ever to undergo eye surgery when his cataracts were removed. Roberto's father, a farmer and his mother, "queen of the house", brother and 8 sisters live together in a small house, 5 meters by 5 meters (15' x 15') with 2 rooms and a kitchen, walls of wood pieces, a tin roof and dirt floor. Roberto's parents walked 30 minutes from their home to catch a bus traveling two hours to reach Visualiza's satellite hospital in Flores in the northern Peten region. His mother said that if the hospital was not there, they could not do anything for Roberto Carlos because they cannot afford to go all the way to Guatemala City. Now, Roberto can see his world, something that may not have been possible for him without this sight-saving surgery.

Onchocerciasis—prevention of "river blindness"

Thanks to the miracle drug Mectizan® (ivermectin) provided free of charge by its manufacturer Merck & Company, the tiny worms that invade the eyes no longer threaten the sight of millions of people in Africa and Latin America. The worms that cause onchocerciasis are passed by flies that breed in fast flowing rivers. One dose of the drug each year kills all the microscopic worms in the body so they never grow to adulthood and while flies still bite, there are no microscopic worms to pass from one person to another. People living near the rivers where the flies breed have moved back to their fertile lands where food is grown more easily. IEF has been distributing Mectizan® for over 17 years and established the first "community-based" Mectizan Distribution Programs in Africa and Latin America in 1990. In 2007, together with the National Onchocerciasis Program in Cameroon, IEF treated everyone at risk of infection in both Adamaoua and South Provinces. Funding from the African Programme for Onchocerciasis Control, the Lions SightFirst Program and our many thousands of individuals ensures that the threat of blindness is eliminated for millions of people because they will continue to get this miracle drug each year.


For nearly 10 years, IEF has focused on sustainability of eye care institutions, investing funds and technical assistance to create patient centered services focusing on quality care, efficiency, productivity and financial self-sufficiency. The network is growing with 14 eye clinics and hospitals in 9 countries around the world. The environments are different and present unique challenges, but the growing number of successful partners are paving the way as models of what a sustainable eye clinic can be.

Support from the de Beaumont Foundation, the Lavelle Fund for the Blind, the Earl & Shirley Herbst Eye Research Fund at the Connecticut Community Foundation, and others are enabling IEF to reach more and more of the many eye clinics requesting our assistance. This year, the Instituto de la Vision in Mexico and its satellite clinics have joined the SightReach® Management network.




