ABOUT IFEM

The International Federation for Emergency Medicine (IFEM) is a global membership-based organization. Our member organizations are the Emergency Medicine professional societies of nations or regions who, in turn, represent their own individual emergency physicians (or nursing/ambulance staff). These member organizations are from emergency care systems in countries ranging from those that are highly developed, to those that are still emerging and developing.

Individuals affiliated with our member organizations include colleagues in the academe, health facility administration and those in frontline care of patients, across all ages, with acute and critical illness or injury. Many of these professionals volunteer their time for IFEM, and are dedicated to sharing their expertise and commitment to make a positive impact on emergency care for all people and communities.



What we do

IFEM creates a global community. We do this by fostering a diverse and inclusive federation of member organizations, where individuals work with colleagues they may not otherwise have the opportunity to meet, and in doing so share experiences and gain perspectives on health systems, training and educational needs.

Event endorsement and promotion

IFEM Awards

IFEM has a number of awards that recognize the contributions of our colleagues in international emergency medical care. A call for nominations is extended annually to all member organizations.

Gautam Bodiwala Lifetime Leadership Achievement Award	The Gautam Bodiwala Lifetime Leadership Achievement Award is IFEM's highest honour. The purpose of the Award is to recognize an individual of a member organization who has demonstrated an extensive and continuous commitment to the International Federation for Emergency Medicine resulting in significant contributions to the development and advancement of the IFEM in addition to extensive and continuous commitment to the specialty of emergency medicine in their own country.
Order of the International Federation of Emergency Medicine	The Order of the IFEM (also known as "Fellowship of the IFEM") is awarded to and reserved for individuals of member organizations who have demonstrated an extensive and continuous commitment to the specialty of emergency medicine in their own country as well as having made significant contributions to supporting the development and advancement of IFEM.
IFEM Humanitarian Award	The IFEM Humanitarian Award recognizes an individual or an organization that has conducted work related to international emergency medicine which has led to major humanitarian or public health benefits or positive effects.

MEMBERSHIP

There are three levels of IFEM Membership:

FULL MEMBERSHIP

A Full Member of IFEM will be the leading national emergency medicine organization for physicians in a country in which emergency medicine is officially recognized as a medical specialty and where there also exists at least one recognized training program in emergency medicine. A Full Member will appoint one representative to the Assembly; this representative will have one full vote. Full Members are eligible to apply for consideration to the right to host IFEM's annual conference, ICEM.

Full Member Benefits

- The right to appoint one member to the Assembly
- The right to one vote
- The right to serve on the Executive or committees subject to regulations
- The right to apply to hold an IFEM conference or symposium
- The right to nominate for awards (subject to payment of small administrative charge)
- The right to state your organization is an IFEM member on your website
- Free addition of events in the IFEM website events calendar
- Addition of your organization website to the IFEM website
- The Committee infrastructure opens a pathway for your members to have an active involvement in creating standards, guidelines, and a unified approach to many common problems
- Annual Complimentary Full Registration for IFEM Assembly Member Representative at the International Conference on Emergency Medicine (ICEM)
- Free advertising for Full Member Annual Scientific Meeting on IFEM event calendar and promotion of event
- Reduced cost to apply for IFEM endorsement of a Research Project or Collaboration



AFFILIATE MEMBERSHIP

An Affiliate Member may be:

- any national emergency medicine organization for physicians practicing emergency medicine in a country where the specialty is not yet officially recognized
- or where residency equivalent training programs do not yet exist
- or if they are a national emergency medicine organization for physicians practicing emergency medicine from a country already represented by a Full or Founding Member
- or any organization whose membership includes practices in the field of emergency medicine but is not exclusively formed of emergency physicians

Affiliate Members may appoint one non-voting member to the Assembly. Affiliate Members are eligible to apply for consideration for the right to host IFEM's annual conference, IFEM and for Awards.

EX-OFFICIO MEMBERSHIP

Ex-officio members are defined as a multinational emergency medicine organization.

- Reduced cost for IFEM endorsement of conferences (subject to approval)
- Reduced cost to advertise jobs on the IFEM website

IFEM MEMBERSHIP FEES

EM societies who join IFEM pay an annual membership fee. This has two components:

- a base fee (Part A) and
- a per capita fee (Part B) calculated for each member of the Organization. Part B is also indexed to the Organization's Gross National Income as published by the World Bank Atlas Method List of Economies as of June 2020.

Annual Subscriptions, fees and charges, and criteria for concessions for member organizations are set by the Board on the recommendation of the Finance Committee.
