Vehicle Information and No Contact Orders

- Requires a person who is subject to a no contact order to provide their vehicle description and information to the courts. This information is then provided to the person protected by the order.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- No Contact Orders- Applicability (664A.2)

A person who fails to comply with the requirements of this bill is guilty of a contempt of court charge.

Section 2 No-Contact Orders- Enforcement of Protective Orders- Entry to Temporary No-Contact Order (664A.3)

When a no contact order is issued, the defendant must provide identifying information about any motor vehicle they own or operate, including work vehicles they operate. This information is submitted to the court who then provides this information to the victim.

The information must include a vehicle make, model, year, color, and license plate.

Initial vehicle information must be filed within ten days and any changes must be filed within five.
