### Medicaid – Insurance Mandates

- Exempts Medicaid and hawk-I programs from state mandates

### Section by Section Analysis

#### Section 1 – Medical assistance and hawk-I programs – applicability of subtitle (505.34)

New code section- Medicaid and hawk-I are not subject to mandates in 515I.

#### Section 2 – Construction (514B)

Managed care organizations that administer Medicaid or hawk-I are only subject to state health insurance laws to the extent it relates to certificate of authority and solvency standards compliance

#### Section 3 – Definitions (515I.2)

Adds managed care organization administering Medicaid or hawk-I to definition of “participating insurer”

#### Section 4 – Duties of surplus lines insurance producers (515I.5)
