Beer Distribution Parity

- Allows for restaurants and bars to make limited retail beer purchases for resale

Allows class “C” beer permit who also holds class “E” liquor license to sell beer to class “B”, class “C”, and special class “C” for resale for consumption on premise. Beer sales in a 24hr period shall be in quantities determined by the ABD

Amendment Analysis

H-8100 by Nordman – Limits retail purchases for resale to a max of five cases in 24hr period. Clarifies the distributor is not liable for retail purchases made by a restaurant or bar.
