Disaster Response Immunity

Waives liability for state officers or employees engaged in the removal of debris or wreckage on public property from the effected local governments during proclaimed disaster emergencies.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Proclamation of disaster emergency by governor (lowa Code 29C.6(4))

Amends existing lowa Code on proclamations of disaster emergency by governor to not hold the state or any of its employees liable when engaged in the removal of debris or wreckage on public property and acting in good faith.

Good faith does not include willful misconduct, gross negligence, or recklessness.
