Water Treatment Systems

Allows for the sale of water treatment devices certified by an accredited independent third party.

Section by Section Analysis

Sections 1-2 – Definitions

Simplifies the definition of contaminant.

Section 3 - Consumer Frauds (714.16)

Defines "health-related contaminant" as a contaminant which has potentially adverse health effects for which a maximum contaminant level or a treatment technique or level of action in lieu of a maximum contaminant level specified in national primary drinking water regulations.

Section 4 – Consumer Frauds (714.16)

Clarifies it is unlawful for a person to sell, lease, rent, or advertise a water treatment system and make claims that the system removes health-related contaminants unless the claims have been certified by an accredited third party.

Section 5 – Effective Date

This act is effective January 1, 2023.

Section 6 - Applicability

Applies to sales, leases, and rentals on or after the effective date.
