Pizza Dough Rollers

- This bill allows 16 and 17-year-old employees to operate pizza dough rollers that are constructed with certain safeguards.
- This does not apply to the setting up, adjusting, repairing, oiling, or cleaning the pizza dough rollers.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1. Section 92.8(1)

This section relates to prohibited occupations for workers under 18. This amends the section to make an exception for certain pizza dough rollers that are a type of dough sheeter that have been constructed with safeguards contained in the basic design to prevent fingers, hands, or clothing from being caught in the in-running point of the rollers, that have gears that are completely enclosed, and that have microswitches that disengage the machinery if the backs or sides of the rollers are removed, and all those operations have not been overridden.

However, this does not apply to the setting up, adjusting, repairing, oiling, or cleaning of pizza dough rollers as described in this section.
