County Attorney- Conflict of Interest

Allows the County Board of Supervisors to hire outside counsel if there is a conflict with the County Attorney.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1- County Home Rule Implementation- Prohibited Action (331.755)

Outlines prohibited actions for county attorneys to avoid conflicts of interest. It specifies that a county attorney cannot:

- 1. Accept fees or rewards from individuals for services related to prosecutions or official business. (Current law)
- 2. Represent parties other than the state or county in actions that are based on similar facts as prosecutions they have conducted. (Current law)
- 3. Receive assistance from another attorney involved in civil actions related to criminal prosecutions they have initiated. (Current law)
- 4. A board of supervisors can hire outside counsel with a majority vote if there is a dispute involving the county attorney.
- 5. A county sheriff can petition a district court to determine if there is a conflict of interest, if the board of supervisors refuses to act. The county may be responsible for all associated court costs and expenses.

Amendment Analysis

H-1245- Bousselot

Strikes the ability for a county sheriff to seek outside counsel if they believe a conflict of interest exists. Sub five of section one.
