The Practice of Threading

- Allows people to practice threading without being licensed by the Board of Cosmetology.

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Definitions (Iowa Code 157.1(5)(c))

Strikes “threading” as a practice from the definition of “cosmetology”

Section 2 – Definitions (Iowa Code 157.1(12)(c))

Excludes the practice of threading as a practice of esthetics.

Section 3 – Threading (Iowa Code 157.12B)

New section – Excludes persons engaged exclusively in the practice of threading from being required to receive a license issued by the board of cosmetology.

“Threading” means the removal of hairs from the eyebrows, upper lip, or other body parts by the use of a thread.
