DAS State Library

- Strikes reporting requirements that are redundant now that State Library is under the Department of Administrative Services.
- Updates Iowa Code to change "access plus" to "interlibrary loan programs".

Section by Section Analysis

Section 1 – Biennial reports — time covered and date of filing (Iowa Code 7a.3(1)(f))

Strikes reference to biennial report of the State librarian. The information in the report is covered in the reports DAS submit. This provision should have been caught in the realignment bill when it was moved to DAS.

Section 2 – Library services — duties and responsibilities (Iowa Code 8A.202(1)(e))

Strikes reference to developing and approving a biennial unified plan for service and delivery for the department.

Section 3 – Library services — duties and responsibilities (Iowa Code 8A.202(1)(k))

Strikes reference to state agency libraries that are no longer relevant.

<u>Section 4 – State librarian — state library fund created (Iowa Code 8A.204(2)(b))</u>

Strikes reference to biennial report of the State librarian. The information in the report is covered in the reports DAS submit. This provision should have been caught in the realignment bill when it was moved to DAS.

Section 5 – Enrich Iowa program (Iowa Code 8A.209(1))

Updates Iowa Code to change "access plus" to interlibrary loan programs.
