## **Place of Trial**

Establishes the place of trial in cases where it may be unclear where the crime was committed.

## **Section by Section Analysis**

Section 1 – Jurisdiction of Public Offenses and Place of Trial- Place of Trial- Special Provisions (803.3)

- 1. If the crime location is unclear: The trial will be held in the county where the victim lives.
- 2. If there is no victim, or the victim lives out of state, or they can't figure out where the victim lives: The trial will be held in the county where the person accused of the crime lives.
- **3.** If the victim is an organization (not a person): The trial can happen in any county where the organization has a physical presence.
- **4. If there are multiple victims**: The trial can be held in any county where one of the victims lives, but if one of the victims is a person, that county takes priority over others.
