### Human Trafficking Definition

- Modifies the definition of services and victim in relation to human trafficking.
- **Fiscal Note** – Fiscal impact cannot be determined, not possible to know how many additional convictions would result from the bill.

### Section by Section Analysis

#### Section 1 – Human Trafficking- Definitions (710A.1)

Amends the definition of services to clarify that there does not need to be an ongoing relationship between the individuals.

#### Section 2 – Human Trafficking- Definitions (710A.1)

Expands the definition of victim to include a person subject to human trafficking (current law), a person identified as being subject to or targeted for human trafficking, a law enforcement officer or agent posing as a person subjected to or a target for human trafficking.

#### Section 3- Vice- Prostitution (725.1)

Amends the definition of human trafficking to include knowingly attempting to or purchasing prostitution services from a law enforcement office, or an agent posing as a person engaged in human trafficking.
