Controlled Substance Updates

- Updates controlled substances in Iowa to comply with federal law.

Section by Section Analysis

House File 182 updates the controlled substances schedules in Iowa by adding new chemical substances and modifying existing regulations. It includes different forms of fentanyl and other synthetic drugs, that are now classified under controlled substances. Additionally, it sets the penalties for violations involving these substances, ranging from class 'B' felonies to aggravated misdemeanors. This keeps Iowa in compliance with federal regulations.
